



Children's Recovery Center Job Description – Medical Provider

The Medical Provider shall be responsible to the elected Board of Directors and shall carry out the purposes, policies, and programs of the Children's Recovery Center as determined by the Board of Directors. The Medical Director shall be a qualified physician or nurse practitioner with expertise in child sexual abuse.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Review pertinent medical and social history before the forensic medical exam.
- Build a rapport with the child to make sure they are as comfortable for the medical exam.
- Provide a complete head to toe physical exam for each child who comes to the CRC.
- Collect any forensic evidence from alleged sexual assault or physical assault.
- Provide lab testing when necessary to test for STD's or other infections.
- The Medical Provider will ask the child about the allegations of sexual abuse or physical abuse to see if the child wants to provide additional information other than was provided in their forensic interview.
- Provide a written report for MDT partners.
- Make referrals for other services (medical, dental, therapy, etc.) that may be needed.
- Must be available to attend monthly MDT meetings on the last Friday of each month.
- Must be available for court testimony when necessary.
- The Medical Provider must be familiar and up-to date with published research studies on findings in abused and non-abused children, sexual transmission of infections in children, and current medical guidelines.
- The Medical Provider must comply with NCA Standards, specifically Standard #1 Multidisciplinary Team and Standard #5 for Medical Evaluation.

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
