This is a full-time leadership position offering a sign-on bonus and relocation assistance.

- This position requires you to participate in quality informatics, policy review including standing orders, provide peer and expert review of forensic examinations, be available by phone to assist with patient care for deviations from standing orders.

Minimum Requirements:

- **Board Certification:** Board eligible or board certified in Pediatrics
- **Training:** Successful completion of pediatric residency program and successful completion of ACGME-accredited Pediatric Child Abuse Fellowship.
- **Licensure:** Current unrestricted license to practice medicine in the State of Virginia.
- **Certification:** Basic Life Support (BLS) upon start.
- **Payer Credentialing:** Ability to successfully complete the credentialing process by third-party payors and Ability to enrolled as a CMS Medicare/Medicaid payor
- **Medical Staff Credentialing:** Successful completion of credentialing for Medical Staff membership and appropriate clinical privileges sufficient to perform all required services
